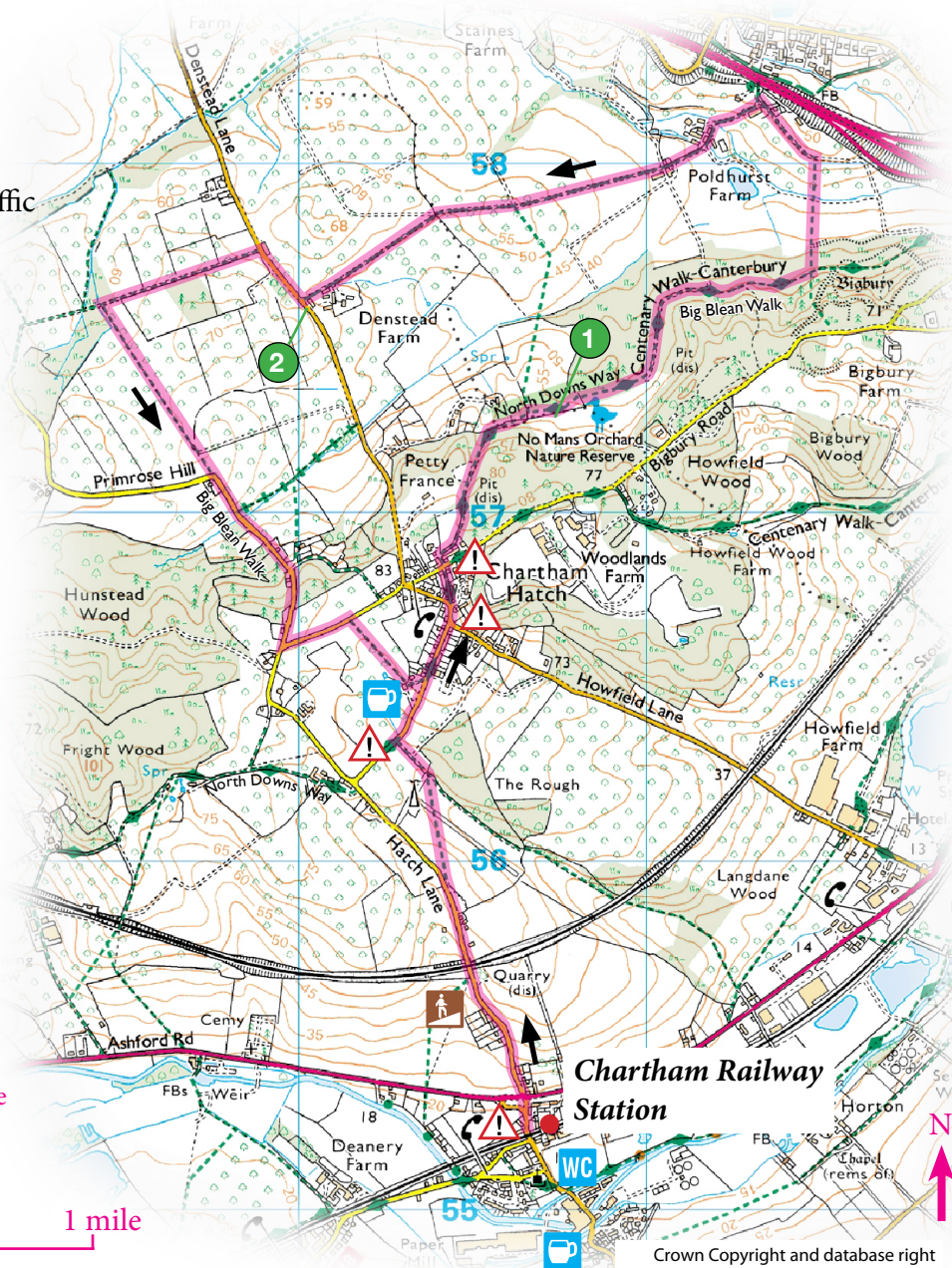
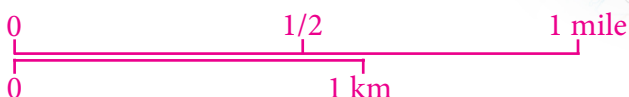


A Taste of Traditional Kent
